- 1) Which of the animals in the garden spoke to Adam's wife? *Serpent (v. 1)*
- 2) The serpent asked the woman if God forbade them to eat from all trees of the garden. Was this the truth or a lie? *Lie. (v. 1)*
- 3) The woman said to the serpent that they could eat of the fruit of all trees of the garden except of one tree that was in the middle of the garden, because they would die. Was this the truth or a lie? *Truth. (v. 2, 3)*
- 4) The serpent said to the woman that they would not die. Was this the truth or a lie? *Lie. (v. 4)*
- 5) The serpent said to the woman that when they eat of the fruit, they would be wise like God. *Was this the truth or a lie? Lie. (v. 5, 6)*
- 6) What did man and woman know after they ate the fruits? *They knew that they were naked. (v. 7)*
- 7) What kind of leaves they saw together to make themselves aprons? *Fig leaves. (v. 7)*
- 8) What did the man and woman do when they heard God coming? *They hid themselves. (v. 8)*
- 9) Why did they hid themselves from God? *They were afraid of God, because they were naked. (v. 10)*
- 10) Who did man say that gave him the fruit to eat? *The wife whom God gave him. (v. 12)*
- 11) Who did woman say that deceived her about eating of the fruit? *The serpent (v. 13)*
- 12) How did God punish the serpent? *It would have to crawl on his belly. (v. 14)*
- 13) Did God predict that the woman's child would destroy the serpent? *Yes. (v. 15)*
- 14) How did God punish the woman? *With pain and submission. (v. 16)*
- 15) How did God punish Adam? *With hard work and death. (v. 17, 19)*
- 16) What did Adam call his wife's name? *Eve (v. 20)*
- 17) Out of what God made coats for Adam and his wife? *Skins of animals. (v. 21)*
- 18) Did God let Adam and his wife to stay in the garden after they disobeyed him? *No. (v. 22)*
- 19) What was Adam's work after God sent him away from the garden? *He was a farmer. (v. 23)*
- 20) Who did God place at the garden with a flaming sword to guard the way to the tree of life? *The cherubim. (v. 24)*
