- 1) What were the names of two of the sons of Adam and Eve? Cain and Abel. (v. 1, 2)
- 2) What was Abel's work? A shepheard of sheep. (v. 2)
- 3) What was Cain's work? A farmer. (v. 2)
- 4) What kind of sacrifice Cain brought to God? Fruit of the ground. (v. 3)
- 5) What kind of sacrifice Abel brought to God? Sheep. (v. 4)
- 6) Which of the sacrifices God accepted? Abel's. (v. 4, 5)
- 7) Was Cain very angry because God accepted Abel's sacrifice, but not his sacrifice? Yes. (v. 5)
- 8) Would God accept Cain if Cain did what was good? Yes. (v. 7)
- 9) What would happen to Cain if he did not do what was good? He would be a slave of sin. (v. 7)
- 10) What did Cain do to his brother Abel in the field? *He killed him. (v. 8)*
- 11) What did Cain say to God when He asked him where was Abel? He said that he did not know. (v. 9)
- 12) Whose blood was crying to God from the ground? Abel's shed blood. (v. 10)
- 13) How did God punish Cain? He would be a fugitive and a wanderer on the earth. (v. 12)
- 14) Was Cain afraid that he could be killed? Yes. (v. 14)
- 16) What did God put on Cain that he would not be killed? *A mark. (v. 15)*
- 17) What was the name of the land where Cain moved? Nod. (v. 16)
- 18) Did Cain get married and have children? Yes. (v. 17)
- 19) What was the name of a child that God gave to Adam and Eve instead of Abel? Seth. (v. 25)
- 20) Did Seth's family begin to worship God? Yes. (v. 26)
